

MINUTES OF GBM JAIPUR 2010


1. Minutes of the last GBM at Udaipur passed

8. Eligibility for post of Vice President, ROS
 - o Minimum 50 years of age
 - o 15 years of regular membership of ROS
 - o Has attended atleast 5 annual conference of ROS in last 15 years with atleast 2 in the preceding 5 years
 - o Held any post in ROS executive in the last 15 years
 - o Has contributed towards ROS activities in form of organizing ROS conference, or paper presentation in conference or article in ROS journal or contribution in any form for enhancement of ROS which the ROS executive deems fit for recognition.
 - o Has not been charged for any indiscipline of any form in ROS in last 15 years

This was approved by the house.

9. Expense of registration of Former Presidents of ROS to be borne by ROS and not LOC was passed by the house.
10. The house agreed to hold 2 CMEs per year and sanctioned a sum of upto Rs. 50000/- for actual expenses incurred.
11. 2 PG Resident Training Programme in PG Training Institutes. The house agreed to this proposal.
12. 2 Traveling Fellowships on the lines of AIOS Fellowships for ROS members below 40 years of age. The ROS member should have a minimum of 2 years of membership. Modalities of selection to be worked out by a committee to be formed by the Hony. General Secretary.
13. Proposal by IMA Jaipur for donation to JMA building fund, in return of which certain life long facilities to be given to ROS. The decision was left to the next executive.
14. Dr. P. K. Mathur raised the issue of Anonymous letter against him. He informed the house of the accounts of AIOC 2009. The house anonymously condemned such tactics and accepted the version give by Dr. Mathur.

Eligibility of Vice President R.O.S.


1. Minimum 50 years of Age.
2. 15 Years of regular member of R.O.S.
3. Attending at least 5 (Five) conferences in last 15 years with at least 2 in preceding 5 years when nomination is considered by R.O.S. Executive.
4. Held any post in R.O.S. Executive in last 15 years.
5. Has contributed towards R.O.S. activities in form of organizing R.O.S. conference, or paper presentation in conference or article in R.O.S. journal or contribution in any form for enhancement of R.O.S. which the R.O.S. executive deems fit for recognition.
6. Has not been charged for any in discipline of any form in R.O.S. in last 15 years


To delegate powers to the President:-
